IBG ACTION PLANS – 3 IBG PRIORITIES

1. Influencing UK Infrastructure Export Strategy and Government funding

- Collaborate with DfIT, more support from IBG members in September
- Construction Leadership Council (CLC) leads on exports (Vince Clancy CEO of T&T) as part of Industrial strategy sector deal and the leads construction export strategy. Role for IBG to support the work of CLC.
- DfIT UK Infrastructure Exports set up in 2017 to support the sector deal Terms of Reference may not align with Competition and Markets restrictions Prioritisation of projects, sharing market intelligence, joining criteria unclear, outputs not clearly defined or published.
- Next IBG meeting 15/16 September 2019 will be used to table the draft export strategy



2. Developing Network Capability for firms wishing to work overseas

- Networking event to seek clarity on activity of CLC and UKIE, HV will scope up the event and agenda with correct keynote speakers. Target date late Autumn 2019
- Export strategy document due for issue on 15th October 2019

3. Influencing International procurement and contract law

- Is there anything worth influencing?
- Are other business models worth exploring
- Unlimited liability
- World Bank Procurement procedures and guidelines are well established
- DfID transferring risk to suppliers through ULL as are other UK government Departments
- ACE /IBG to review how we educate member organisations on key issues ULL, Subrogation of rights, Net Contribution Clauses, Safeguarding and Compliance etc
- What does good look like? ACE about to issue a report
- ACE to get feedback from Members insurers, FIDIC on international view on trends in insurances
