

Best Collaborative Award – Partnership

(Client, contractor, community or cross-sector partnership)

Recognises partnerships that delivered exceptional outcomes through collaboration.

How to Enter

Step 1: Confirm Eligibility

Ensure your business meets the entry criteria. Any consulting firm that satisfies the requirements is eligible to enter the Engineering and Consultancy Awards 2026.

Step 2: Appoint a Lead Contact

Nominate a lead contact within your organisation who will act as the primary point of contact throughout the awards programme. This individual will coordinate submissions, manage any interviews, and oversee guest arrangements for the Awards Gala Dinner, where winners will be announced.

Step 3: Select Award Categories

Review the available award categories and select the most appropriate category or categories for your entry. Organisations may submit entries to multiple categories.

Step 4: Prepare Your Submission

Draft your responses in advance of completing the online nomination form. Entry forms can be previewed prior to submission, and a blank PDF worksheet is provided within the submission pack to support collaborative working before final submission.

Step 5: Submit Your Entry

Submit your completed entry, along with any supporting documentation, by **Friday 22 May**.

Step 6: Judging Process

All submissions are reviewed for compliance with the entry criteria before being assessed and scored by the judging panel against defined judging standards.

Step 7: Shortlist Announcement

The shortlist will be announced on **Wednesday 16 September**, and all entrants will be notified of the outcome of their submission.

Step 8: Awards Ceremony

Final winners will be announced at the Awards Ceremony and Gala Dinner on **Wednesday 2 December**, held at the Royal Garden Hotel, London.
