### Assessment Criteria

Each question will be scored out of a maximum of 10 points. Entrants are encouraged to provide comprehensive and detailed responses.

Entries should demonstrate:

- Successful delivery of a new-build, refurbishment, retrofit or adaptive reuse project, meeting programme, budget and quality objectives.
- Strong technical expertise, effective collaboration and professional problem-solving throughout the project lifecycle.
- Clear evidence of improved building or place performance, including operational efficiency, user outcomes or post-completion evaluation.
- Positive environmental, social or economic impact, including carbon reduction, resource efficiency and the effective upgrading of existing buildings where applicable.
- Innovative approaches or best practice that enhance the building or place and deliver long-term value and a positive legacy.
