## Assessment Criteria

Each question will be scored out of a maximum of 10 points. Entrants are encouraged to provide comprehensive and detailed responses.

Entries should demonstrate:

- Effective JV governance and culture, including shared objectives and aligned incentives
- Integrated teams and delivery, across organisations and disciplines
- Improved outcomes for the client, such as cost, programme, quality, safety or risk reduction
- Innovation enabled by the JV, including solutions that would not have been possible through traditional delivery
- A positive legacy, including lessons learned and future applicability

Judges will look for clear evidence of what the joint venture uniquely enabled.
